### Statistics Request Overall Description

On May 17, 2022, Research and Statistics received a request for a report comparing the number of pretrial interviews receiving Administrative Release to the number of pretrial interviews with failure to appear (FTA) resulting in a bench warrant.

PRIM, the information system used by Pretrial Services, was queried for interview, case, and bond data for any interview in which a period of pretrial custody ended from 1/1/2014 to 3/31/2022 and for any interview in which the most recent failure to appear occurred from 1/1/2014 to 3/31/2022.

A pretrial interview may apply to multiple cases simultaneously, may receive one or more release decisions over time, and related failures to appear may apply to multiple cases simultaneously if hearings are held concurrently. The most recent release decision and outcome for any related case is reported for each interview uniquely for each jurisdiction (Circuit and District Court). If a single interview has at least one Circuit case and at least one District case, release decisions, release outcomes, and time in custody will be reported separately for each jurisdiction. A defendant is not considered released unless they are indicated as released on ALL cases of that jurisdiction included in an interview. For instance, a defendant may receive a recognizance bond for a case with minor charges but remain in custody on cash bail on a separate case. An interview is identified as having a failure to appear if the most recent failure to appear related to any case of the specified jurisdiction occurred during the queried date range.

### Statistical Report (22\_PINS8010)

The report consists of five (5) pages. The first page includes a visualization comparing Administrative Release and FTA Warrants, while the remaining pages include cross-tabulations presenting information about all Release Outcomes and Failure to Appear Outcomes.

#### Page 1: Comparison of Administrative Release and Failure to Appear Warrants

This visualization presents the number of pretrial interviews with the Release Outcome *Administrative Release* and the number of pretrial interviews with the FTA Outcome *Warrant Info* with each set of interviews on the same date range and quantitative axis. The same presentation is repeated separately for Circuit and District Court. The blue area represents the number of interviews receiving Administrative Release with the date indicating the Custody End Date. The red line represents the number of interviews with failure to appear and the FTA Outcome *Warrant Info* with the date indicating Failure to Appear date. Dates are partitioned by quarter and calendar year (CY).

## Statistical Report (22\_PINS8010)

### Pages 2-3: Release Outcomes

The cross-tabulation presents the number of pretrial interviews grouped by CY and quarter of Custody End Date and Release Outcome, including all Release Outcomes except release in error, escape, and transfer to another secure facility. The table on Page 2 includes Circuit Court interviews and the table on Page 3 includes District Court interviews.

### Pages 4-5: Failure to Appear Outcomes

The cross-tabulation presents the number of Circuit Court pretrial interviews with Failure to Appear grouped by the CY and quarter of FTA Date and FTA/Warrant Outcome. FTA Outcomes are grouped with those outcomes involving a warrant having a separate subtotal apart from those receiving other outcomes. Those outcomes grouped as *FTA Warrants* are those that are presented on the first page. The table on Page 4 includes Circuit Court interviews and the table on Page 5 includes District Court interviews.

### Statistical Analysis Considerations:

- These statistics represent a snapshot in time of the data as it existed on the date the report was generated (5/18/2022).
- Release Outcomes and failures to appear are assessed separately for each Jurisdiction (Circuit or District Court). Interviews with cases in both jurisdictions are counted separately in each jurisdiction.
- Release Outcome reporting excludes release by error, escape, or transfer to another secure facility.
- A Pretrial Interview consists of a discrete period of custody and any subsequent period of pretrial release. A single interview may involve one or more cases, and a single individual may be involved in multiple interviews over time.
- The end of pretrial custody for each case is determined by the earlier of either the disposition date of the case (recorded as the alternative release code Disposed Prior to Release) or release date from the most recent bond if the bond resulted in pretrial release. For each interview, the end of custody is determined as the latest date determined in this way for any case related to the interview. Some interviews may contain a combination of cases with pretrial release on a bond and cases that reached disposition without pretrial release.

**Indictment Summons:** Indicates that a defendant already released on a District Felony case was not brought back into custody following an indictment, but that the same release conditions were maintained by the Circuit Court and the defendant was issued a summons. There is no time in custody for this outcome.

**60-Day Rule:** Released after 60 days of pretrial custody on a District Court case.

**Indictment:** Indicates that pretrial custody on one or more District cases ended with an indictment to Circuit Court while the defendant was in pretrial custody. Indictment outcomes reported outside of the District-Felony group typically result from expungement or charges amended up following the initial filing of the case.

**Detained Until Disposition:** Without being given pretrial release, the defendant was released upon the disposition of all cases in this interview from a given jurisdiction.

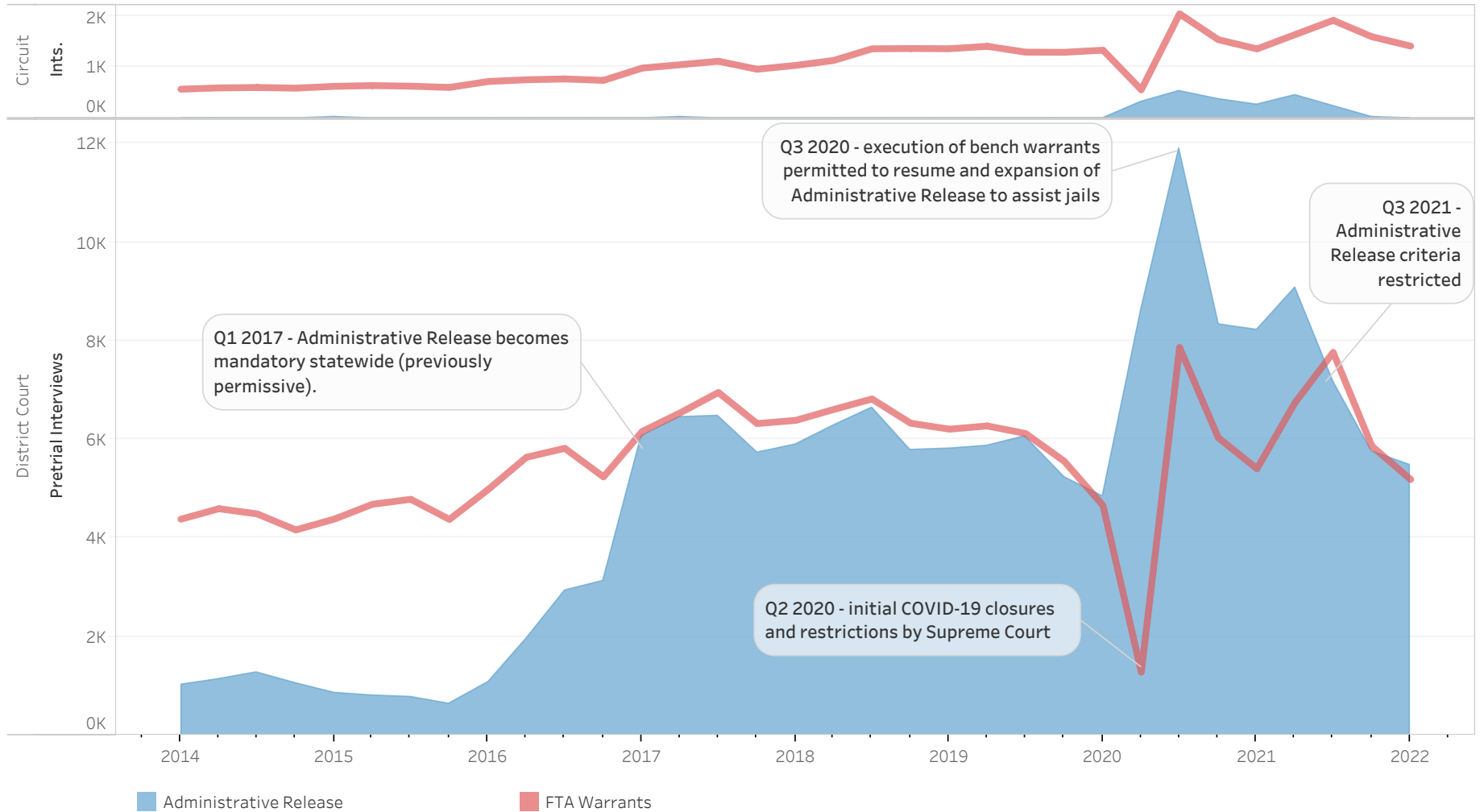
