Statistics Request Overall Description

On April 17, 2023, Hope's Wings requested from Research and Statistics a report of domestic violence related charges disposed statewide during calendar years (CY) 2018 through 2022 and domestic violence and interpersonal cases filed CY 21 and 22.

CourtNet, which provides a summary of cases statewide, was queried for domestic violence related charges disposed 1/1/2018 through 12/31/2022 statewide. A list of the related UOR codes is provided along with the completed report.

The Historical Caseload by jurisdiction dashboard¹, found on the Kentucky Court of Justice website (available to the public), was used to find a count of Domestic Violence and Interpersonal Protection cases filed 1/1/2021 through 12/31/2022 statewide.

The AOC assigns and maintains codes that are used within the Court of Justice Case Management System for statistical and reporting purposes. These codes are used to identify local and city ordinances, as well as codes for general administrative purposes. The AOC official list of UOR Codes with KRS number and descriptor can be obtained at the Court of Justice Website at [Analytics - Kentucky Court of Justice \(kycourts.gov\)](https://www.kycourts.gov/Analytics-Kentucky-Court-of-Justice). A query for data based on specified charges will include each UOR code specified and possible supplemental codes. The first six digits are specific to that charge. The seventh digit indicates if there is a supplemental code. A "0" as the seventh digit means that is the primary UOR code and it does not have a supplemental code. If there are supplemental codes, the "0" will change to a 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, or 6 (the numbering corresponds to the list above). An enhancement does not exist on all UOR codes. When a supplemental code does not appear within a dataset, charge(s) did not occur during this period. The presence of "*obs" within the description of a UOR code indicates an obsolete UOR code. However, the code is still present within the KYCourts/CourtNet database and may still be utilized. Not every UOR code included in the query will have charges associated with it in each calendar year examined. Some cases may contain multiple charges; therefore, charge counts may exceed case counts. The number of cases cannot be inferred as the number of individuals as multiple cases may have the same defendant.
