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## KRS CHAPTER 202A INVOLUNTARY HOSPITALIZATION CASES FILED CALENDAR YEAR 2021 STATEWIDE

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June 29, 2022

### Statistics Request Overall Description

On June 20, 2022, Research and Statistics received a request for a report of cases filed under KRS Chapter 202A calendar year (CY) 2021 statewide.

CourtNet, which provides a summary of cases statewide, was queried for Involuntary Hospitalization/Admission and Disability (case number type H) cases filed statewide January 1, 2021 through December 31, 2021 (CY 21).

KRS Chapter 202A involuntary hospitalization cases were identified as those cases having a Petition for Involuntary Hospitalization (PIH) initiating document entered. These cases were then searched for whether an order for examination was entered within the case.

Orders for examination include the following document type codes:

- OE – Order for Examination
- CEH – Examination Order and Examination for Involuntary Hospitalization.

### Statistical Report (22\_RS3161)

Report 22\_RS3161 provides KRS Chapter 202A cases filed CY21 statewide and provides a count of those cases with an order for examination entered.

#### Statistical Analysis Considerations:

- The statistics represent a snapshot in time, as of June 28, 2022.
- Report includes KRS Chapter 202A cases *only*. Other hospitalization case types, such as those proceedings under KRS Chapters 222 and 387, are *not included* in this report.
- Cases with Petitions for Court Ordered Outpatient Treatment (PCAOT) were excluded from this report.
- A case may consist of one or multiple documents. The report's count of cases represents a distinct count of case numbers, regardless of the number of documents associated with the case.
- Counts of cases do not necessarily represent counts of unique individuals.
