Statistics Request Overall Description

On January 17, 2023, the Legislative Research Commission requested from Research and Statistics sentence information on specified charges convicted during CY 2021–CY 2022 statewide. The charges included in this report are provided on the Supplemental Report.

CourtNet, which provides a summary of cases statewide, was queried for the specified charges convicted (“GUILTY”, “GUILTY - MULTIPLE COUNTS”, “PRE-PAYABLE CITATION – PAID” or “GUILTY - SEALED SENTENCE”) from 1/1/2021 through 12/31/2022. Sentence information is provided for each of the convicted charges. The sentence information only represents individual charge sentence information and does not provide the overall punishment for the case/individual.

Sentencing Information

Sentence entries for each charge may consist of the Sentence Imposed, along with any amount probated, suspended, and/or conditionally discharged, and/or sentenced to home incarceration.

The Net Sentence for each charge can be determined by subtracting the amounts probated, suspended, conditionally discharged and home incarceration (Sentence Modifications) from the Sentence Imposed.

$$\text{Sentence Imposed} - \text{Sentence Modifications} = \text{Net Sentence}$$

Convictions of sentences with incarceration may be fully or partially suspended. When the total amount of sentence modifications is equal to the sentenced imposed, the sentence may be considered fully suspended.

The amount of incarceration time sentenced is indicated as JORP (Jail or Prison). There are additional check boxes available to specifically indicate Jail and Prison, but these are not required, may not be used consistently, and no logical constraints restrict the use of these check boxes to given amounts of incarceration time sentenced. Some prison incarceration sentences of greater than a year may be served in county jails.

The Net Fine Amount for each charge can be determined by subtracting the amount suspended/probated, or conditionally discharged (Fine Modifications) from the Fine Amount Imposed.

$$\text{Fine Amount Imposed} - \text{Fine Modifications} = \text{Net Fine Amount}$$

Statistics Request Overall Description

The Net Court Costs for each charge can be determined by subtracting the amount suspended/probated, or conditionally discharged (Court Cost Modifications) from the Court Costs Imposed.

$$\text{Court Costs Imposed} - \text{Court Cost Modifications} = \text{Net Court Costs}$$

Amounts of time are entered in separate fields for years, months, days, and hours. To calculate a total, these should be combined into a common unit as needed.

Factors which affect the overall remaining sentence:

- When multiple sentences of imprisonment are imposed on a defendant for more than one (1) charge the multiple sentence time intervals can be ordered to run concurrently or consecutively as determined by the court at the time of sentence. The concurrent/consecutive indicator does not distinguish the charge(s) or case(s) the sentence was ordered to be concurrent/consecutive with.
 - a. Concurrent Sentence: A sentence for a conviction that a court orders a defendant to serve simultaneously with the defendant's sentence for a different conviction. A sentence may be fully or partially concurrent.
 - b. Consecutive Sentence: A sentence for a conviction that a court orders a defendant to serve only after he has discharged a sentence for a different conviction. A sentence may be fully or partially consecutive.
- There are additional checkboxes to capture conditional discharge time. These checkboxes are not taken into consideration within this report. These charges may be reported in the "other penalty" category.
- Probation violations involve conduct that violates any judicial order imposing supervision of a defendant. Violations of probation and supervised release may result in "Probation Revocation" which is the annulment, cancellation, or reversal of an act, with regard to probation or supervised release, the term generally refers to the judicial act of canceling the supervision in response to offender violation of the terms of supervision and imposing a term of incarceration.
- Shock probation is a form of conditional early release from prison (before the full term of imprisonment expires). Upon violation of a parole condition, a parolee may be placed back in prison to complete the remainder of the sentence. (KRS 439.265)
- Set Aside/Vacated Sentence When a sentence for one or more charges is set aside or vacated, the sentence information is removed and can no longer be reported.
- Expungement of Conviction When one or more charges within a case is granted expungement, it can no longer be reported as the sentence information as these charges are removed as part of the expungement process.

Page 1: Provides a horizontal bar graph (**Figure 1**) with the charges convicted grouped by KRS and charge level. The cross table (**Table 1**) provides the counts of the charges in Figure 1, along with the distinct count of cases.

Page 2: Provides a horizontal bar graph (**Figure 2**) with the charges convicted grouped by KRS and charge level per CY. The cross table (**Table 2**) provides the counts of the charges in Figure 2, along with the distinct count of cases.

Pages 3 through 9 Provide Circuit Court criminal case (CR) sentence information.

Page 3: Provides a cross table (**Table 3**) of the convicted charges, percent of charges and the distinct count of cases sorted by the highest sentence penalty per each of the convicted charges.

A sentence can have more than one penalty, this table reports the charge by the first penalty criterion satisfied in the hierarchy below:

- Incarcerated Prison
- Incarcerated Jail
- Alternative Home Incarceration
- Alternative Probation
- Alternative Conditionally Discharged
- Pay Fine
- Pay Court Cost
- No Sentence
- Alternative/Other Penalty

*Note: For this report no such charges were indicated as having *Death, Life, or 25 Years No Parole*, during the specified timeframe.

Page 4: Provides a cross table (**Table 4**) with the charges with jail/prison time imposed:

Sentenced Imposed:

The total prison/jail sentences imposed is equal to the sum of (a + b + c)

The total prison/jail net sentence is equal to the sum of (a + b)

- a. Time imposed partially suspended/probated, or conditionally discharged.
- b. Time imposed was not suspended/probated, or conditionally discharged.
- c. Time imposed totally suspended/probated, or conditionally discharged.

Probated: The total charges given probation is equal to the sum of (d + e)

- d. Charges with supervised probation.
- e. Charges with unsupervised probation.

Note: Charges can be given multiple conditions therefore, the same charge may be counted in multiple sentence alternative conditions categories.

Page 7: Provides a continuation of cross table (**Table 7**) for KRS 218A.1422 & 218A.1430 sorted by sentence penalty type per sentence alternatives listed above.

Page 8: Provides a cross table (**Table 8**) has the convictions in which the sentence included a fine amount imposed. The total charges with fines imposed is equal to the sum of (a + b + c).

- a. Charges with a fine amount imposed, *partially* suspended, or conditionally discharged.
- b. Charges with a fine amount imposed, *not* suspended, probated, or conditionally discharged.
- c. Charges with a fine amount imposed, *totally* suspended, probated, or conditionally discharged.

Page 9: Provides a cross table (**Table 9**) has the convictions in which the sentence included court costs imposed. The total charges with court costs imposed is equal to the sum of (a + b + c).

- a. Charges with cost amount imposed, *partially* suspended, or conditionally discharged.
- b. Charges with cost amount imposed, *not* suspended, probated, or conditionally discharged.
- c. Charges with cost amount imposed, *totally* suspended, probated, or conditionally discharged.

Pages 10 through 16 Provide sentence information in the same format as Circuit Court sentence information, except for the District Court traffic (T), misdemeanor (M) and felony (F) cases.

Page 10: The cross table (**Table 10**) provide charges by the highest sentence penalty.

Page 15: The cross table (**Table 15**) those which the sentence included a fine amount imposed.

Page 16: The cross table (**Table 16**) those which the sentence included court costs imposed.

Statistical Analysis Considerations:

- These statistics represent a snapshot in time as of the date the data was queried.
- The sentence information in this report represents only the sentence ordered for that *charge* and does not provide the overall punishment for the case or for the individual.
- Sentence time entered represents the sentence ordered by the court. Subsequent modifications by the Department of Corrections to the length of incarceration is not reflected in this report.
- A case may consist of one or multiple charges. The report’s count of cases represents a distinct count of case numbers, regardless of the number of charges within the case.
- Counts of cases do not necessarily represent counts of unique individuals.
- Charges consist of all original and amended charges within a case.

The first six digits are specific to that charge. The seventh digit indicates if there is a supplemental code. A "0" as the seventh digit means that is the primary UOR code and it does not have a supplemental code. If there are supplemental codes, the "0" will change to a 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, or 6 (the numbering corresponds to the list above). An enhancement does not exist on all UOR codes. When a supplemental code does not appear within a dataset, charge(s) did not occur during this period. The presence of "*obs" within the description of a UOR code indicates an obsolete UOR code. However, the code is still present within the KYCourts/CourtNet database and may still be utilized. Not every UOR code included in the query will have charges associated with it in each calendar year examined. Some cases may contain multiple charges; therefore, charge counts may exceed case counts. The number of cases cannot be inferred as the number of individuals as multiple cases may have the same defendant.

Figure 1: Charges Convicted per Jurisdiction

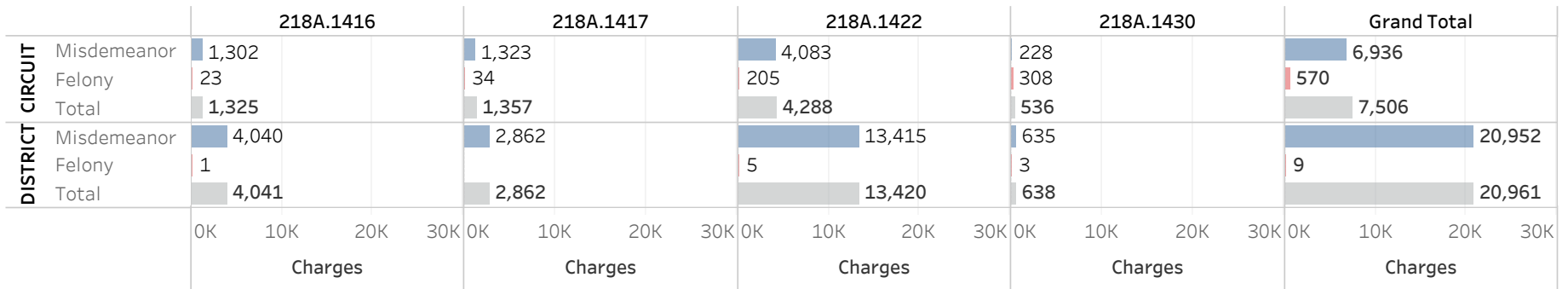

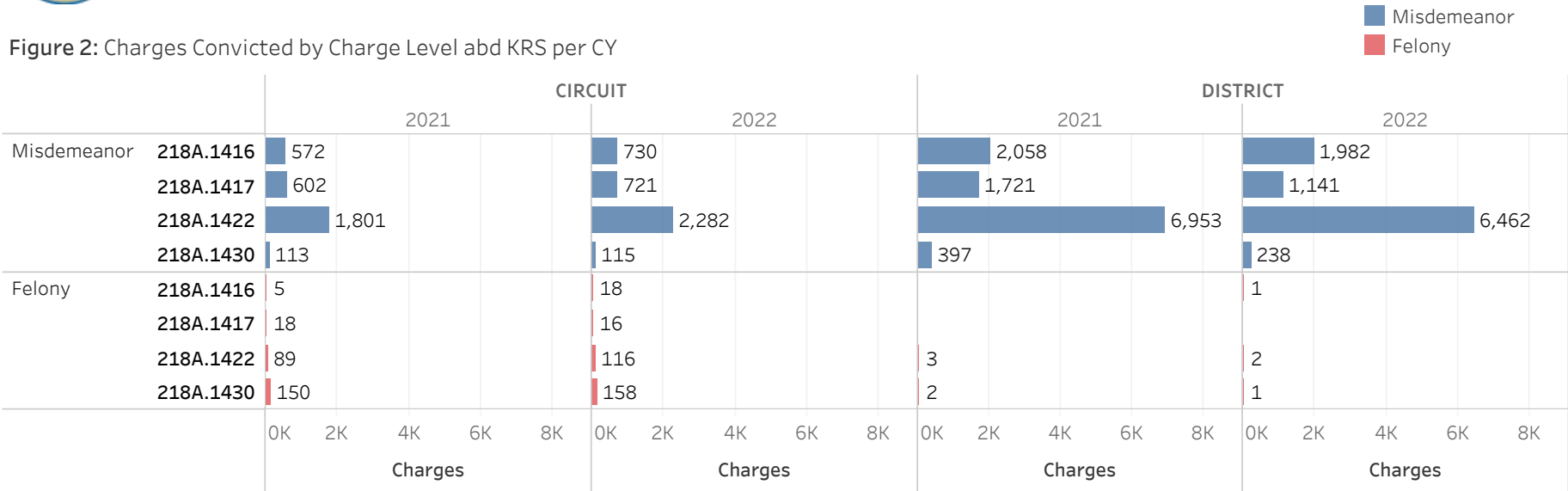
