### Statistics Request Overall Description

On May 4, 2022, Jared Bennett, with Kentucky Center for Investigative Reporting, requested from Research and Statistics the number of people sentenced to home incarceration in Jefferson County and Statewide since 2017.

CourtNet, which provides a summary of cases statewide, was queried for Jefferson County charges convicted (“GUILTY”, “GUILTY - MULTIPLE COUNTS”, or “GUILTY - SEALED SENTENCE”) within Circuit Court (CR) cases and District (T, M & F) non-prepayable cases during January 1, 2017 – December 31, 2022.

### Sentencing Information

Sentence entries for each charge may consist of the Sentence Imposed, along with any amount probated, suspended, and/or conditionally discharged, and/or sentenced to home incarceration.

The Net Sentence for each charge is determined by subtracting the amounts probated, suspended, conditionally discharged, and home incarceration (Sentence Modifications) from the Sentence Imposed.

$$\text{Sentence Imposed} - \text{Sentence Modifications} = \text{Net Sentence}$$

Convictions of sentences with incarceration may be fully or partially suspended. When the total amount of sentence modifications is equal to the sentenced imposed, the sentence may be considered fully suspended.

The amount of incarceration time sentenced is indicated as JORP (Jail or Prison). There are additional check boxes available to specifically indicate Jail and Prison, but these are not required, may not be used consistently, and no logical constraints restrict the use of these check boxes to given amounts of incarceration time sentenced. Some prison incarceration sentences of greater than a year may be served in county jails.

Factors which affect the overall remaining sentence:

- When multiple sentences of imprisonment are imposed on a defendant for more than one (1) crime, the multiple sentence time intervals can be ordered to run concurrently or consecutively as determined by the court at the time of sentencing. The concurrent/consecutive indicator does not distinguish the charge(s) or case(s) the sentence was ordered to be concurrent/consecutive with.

### Statistics Request Overall Description

- a. Concurrent Sentence: A sentence for a conviction that a court orders a defendant to serve simultaneously with the defendant's sentence for a different conviction. A sentence may be fully or partially concurrent.
  - b. Consecutive Sentence: A sentence for a conviction that a court orders a defendant to serve only after he has discharged a sentence for a different conviction. A sentence may be fully or partially consecutive.
- There are additional checkboxes to capture conditional discharge time. These checkboxes are not taken into consideration within this report. These charges may be reported in the "other penalty" category.
  - Probation violations involve conduct that violates any judicial order imposing supervision of a defendant. Violations of probation and supervised release may result in Probation Revocation: the judicial act of canceling the supervision and imposing a term of incarceration in response to the defendant violating the terms of supervision.
  - Shock probation is a form of conditional early release from prison (before the full term of imprisonment expires). Upon violation of a parole condition, a parolee may be placed back in prison to complete the remainder of the sentence. (KRS 439.265)
  - Set Aside/Vacated Sentence When a sentence for one or more charges is set aside or vacated, the sentence information is removed and can no longer be reported.
  - Expungement of Conviction When one or more charges within a case is granted expungement, it can no longer be reported as the sentence information for these charges is removed as part of the expungement process.

### Statistical Tables (22\_RS3045)

This report provides sentencing information for convicted charges within Circuit Criminal (CR) cases and District Criminal (T, M & F) non-prepayable cases calendar years 2017-2022 (January 1, 2017 – December 31, 2022) in Jefferson County and Statewide.

Page 1: Provides a cross table (**Table 1**) of the convicted charges per Jurisdiction, percent of charges and the distinct count of cases sorted by the highest sentence penalty.

A sentence can have more than one penalty, this table reports the charge by the first penalty criterion satisfied in the hierarchy below:

- Incarcerated Prison
- Incarcerated Jail
- Alternative Home Incarceration
- Alternative Probation
- Alternative Conditionally Discharged
- Pay Fine
- Pay Court Cost
- No Sentence
- Alternative/Other Penalty

Note: This table excludes charges which were sentenced to *Life, Death, or 25 Years No Parole*.

### Statistical Tables (22\_RS3045)

The second cross table (**Table 2**) provides the charges which were sentenced to home incarceration time. *Incarcerated Jail* includes charges sentenced to jail as well as home incarceration time per CY.

**Page 2:** Provides a cross table (**Table 3**) same as Table 1 limited to *Circuit Criminal* Cases and per CY.

**Page 3:** Provides a cross table (**Table 4**) same as Table 1 limited to non-prepayable *District Criminal* Cases and per CY.

**Page 4:** Provides a cross table (**Table 5**) of alternative sentence conditions by sentence penalty type for the *Circuit Criminal* and non-prepayable *District Criminal* Cases.

#### Statistical Analysis Considerations:

- These statistics represent a snapshot in time as of the date the data was queried.
- The sentence information in this report represents only the sentence ordered for that charge and does not provide the overall punishment for the case or the individual.
- Sentence time entered represents the sentence ordered by the court. Subsequent modifications by the Department of Corrections to the length of incarceration is not reflected in this report.
- A case may consist of one or multiple charges. The report's count of cases represents a distinct count of case numbers, regardless of the number of charges within the case.
- Counts of cases do not necessarily represent counts of unique individuals.
- Charges consist of all original and amended charges within a case.

		<p><b>Community Service:</b> The court may order the individual to participate in unpaid work in local community instead of sentence time.</p> <p><b>State Traffic School (STS):</b> A program offered by the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet for only those who have a Kentucky driver's license. Completing the State Traffic School program avoids points assessed on a driver's license and is a plea of guilt, to the charge.</p> <p><b>Pay Fine:</b> A fine not totally suspended, probated, or conditionally discharged.</p> <p><b>Pay Court Cost:</b> A court cost not totally suspended, probated, or conditionally discharged.</p> <p><b>No Sentence:</b> The charge has been disposed as a conviction, however, sentence information has not either been given or entered.</p> <p><b>Other Penalty:</b> Sentence conditions which do not fall into any of the defined categories above.</p>

When a supplemental code does not appear within a dataset, charge(s) did not occur during this period. The presence of "\*obs" within the description of a UOR code indicates an obsolete UOR code. However, the code is still present within the KYCourts/CourtNet database and may still be utilized. Not every UOR code included in the query will have charges associated with it in each calendar year examined. Some cases may contain multiple charges; therefore, charge counts may exceed case counts. The number of cases cannot be inferred as the number of individuals as multiple cases may have the same defendant.
