Supreme Court provides guidance for custody and parenting time orders during the pandemic

The Supreme Court has entered [Administrative Order 2020-14](#) to provide guidance to parties with custody and parenting time orders. The order clarifies that although existing court orders control, reasonable accommodations must be made to account for extenuating circumstances related to the COVID-19 emergency.
