Justices, Judges, Circuit Court Clerks, AOC Executive Officers & Managers and Court Administrators:

Public entrance sign lifting most COVID-19 restrictions now available in 12 languages

We updated the public entrance sign for court facilities on May 18 after the Supreme Court [lifted most COVID-19 related restrictions](#). This sign is titled “New Guidance on Entering Court Facilities” and has now been translated into 11 other languages. This is the only COVID-related sign you currently need to post.

The AOC Department of Language Access has translated this sign into the languages most frequently encountered in judicial centers and courthouses statewide. The sign should be posted at entrances in the languages most commonly encountered in that facility. The signs are 8.5x11 and can be printed in your office by clicking on the language below:
