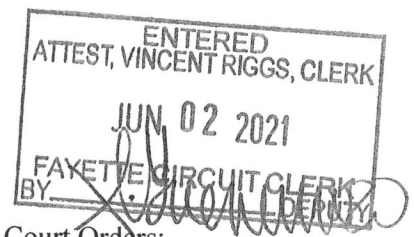


**Fayette Circuit Court**

The Fayette Circuit Court hereby orders the following pursuant to Kentucky Supreme Court Orders:

**CIVIL COURT**

- All Civil Trials may resume, as scheduled.
- All Civil Pretrials may resume by telephone, by Zoom or in-person, per judicial discretion. Please contact each Division for additional information.
- Master Commissioner “In Person” Sales will resume in June.
- All In-Person Civil Motion Hours will resume on Friday, July 16<sup>th</sup>.
