Statistics Request Overall Description

On February 27, 2024, Research and Statistics received a request from a member of the Kentucky General Assembly for an aggregate report of 2nd or greater DUI charges disposed during calendar year (CY) 2023 for underage defendants.

The CourtNet database, which provides a summary of cases statewide, was queried for charges with of DUI offenses disposed during CY 2023. DUI offenses were defined using offense categories defined by the division of Research & Statistics for reporting purposes. A list of applicable offenses is included in this report.

Defendant data, including the age of the defendant party at the time of case filing, was queried for all cases included in the query results. For *Circuit Criminal* cases missing defendant demographics data (as this entry is frequently missing), defendant data was identified from any available *Felony* case cross referenced by Cross Reference Type *Grand Jury*. Identifiers queried included the Criminal History Key, Social Security Number, Driver's License Number, and name. The most valid identifier for each case is identified according to the hierarchy:

- 1. Criminal History Key
- 2. Social Security Number
- 3. Driver's License Number
- 4. Name with date of birth
- 5. Name without date of birth
- 6. Generic Identifier (Expunged, Record Destruction, John Doe)

The validity of each identifier was indicated (see Identification field) and the serial ID Defendant ID was created.

Statistical Table (24_RS6014)

Statistical Table 24_RS6014 provides cross-tabulations with aggregations of DUI charges disposed statewide during CY 2023, distinct cases including these charges, and distinct defendants among these cases identified to the extent possible with CourtNet data:

Page 1: Provides two cross-tabulations of DUI charges disposed. Both tables are grouped by jurisdiction, if the UOR code specified offenders under 21, the DUI offense number (1st, 2nd, unspecified, etc. for that offense for the defendant) specified by code, and the age group of the defendant (15-20, 21-99, or unknown). Counts of charges for each grouping are presented along with counts of distinct cases and distinct defendants which had those charges.

Page 2: Provides a cross-tabulation of DUI charges disposed in District Court cases, limited to charges with defendants of ages between 15 and 20 years at the time of case filing. Results are grouped by if the UOR code specified offenders under 21, the DUI offense number specified by code, and the charge disposition category. Counts of charges for each grouping are presented along with counts of distinct cases and distinct defendants which had those charges.

Page 3: Provides a cross-tabulation with the same content structure as pages 1 and 2 but limited to information pertaining to defendants with an age between 21 and 99 years.

Page 4: Provides two cross-tabulations, the topmost of which has the same content structure as previous pages but limited to information pertaining to defendants with an unknown age. The second cross-tabulation provides a summary with counts of charges, distinct cases, and distinct defendants by age group and defendant identification type.

Pages 5-7: Provide cross-tabulations with the same information presented in pages 1-4 but for Circuit Court.

Page 8: Provides a list of the DUI charges which comprise the report. The UOR, age specified group, offense specified group, and offense description are provided for each UOR code.

- > Statistics represent a snapshot in time, as of the date the data was queried: 3/11/2024.
- A case may consist of one or multiple charges. The report's count of cases represents a distinct count of cases, regardless of the number of charges associated with the case.
- > Counts of cases do not necessarily represent counts of unique individuals.
- Charges consist of all original and amended charges within a case counted separately.
- > DUI charges are often amended to a different offense number after a defendant's criminal history is checked.
- > Many but not all charges heard in Circuit Court were previously heard in District Court and indicted by grand jury. As such, the sum of charges in District and Circuit Court will count some indicted charges twice and totals from the two jurisdictions are presented separately.
- > A defendant may have multiple cases and cases may have multiple charges. Because charges are grouped by age and offense number specified by a UOR code, defendants or cases may have charges with differing groupings. In this situation that defendant or case is counted in both groupings. Similarly, defendants who have cases with different age groups at filing will

be counted in both age groups. This causes subtotals to add to a larger count than overall totals.

The Kentucky State Police (KSP) assigns the Kentucky Uniform Crime Reporting Codes (UOR Codes) to criminal offenses in the Commonwealth of Kentucky. The KSP official list of UOR Codes by KRS number and descriptor can be obtained at the KSP's website at www.kentuckystatepolice.org.

The AOC assigns and maintains codes that are used within the Court of Justice Case Management System for statistical and reporting purposes. These codes are used to identify local and city ordinances, as well as codes for general administrative purposes. The AOC official list of UOR Codes with KRS number and descriptor can be obtained at the Court of Justice Website at courts.ky.gov/aoc/statisticalreports. The AOC UOR Code Listing is for informational purposes only and the information is subject to change, reprogramming, modifications of format, and availability at the direction of the Administrative Office of the Courts (AOC).

A query for data based on specified charges will include each UOR code specified and possible supplemental codes. Supplemental codes (or "ASCF" codes) to any UOR code include: 1) attempt, 2) solicitation, 3) conspiracy, 4) facilitation, 5) complicity, and 6) enhancement. In total, UOR codes contain seven digits. The first six digits are specific to that charge. The seventh digit indicates if there is a supplemental code. A "0" as the seventh digit means that is the primary UOR code and it does not have a supplemental code. If there are supplemental codes, the "0" will change to a 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, or 6 (the numbering corresponds to the list above). An enhancement does not exist on all UOR codes. When a supplemental code does not appear within a dataset, charge(s) did not occur during this period. The presence of "*obs" within the description of a UOR code indicates an obsolete UOR code. However, the code is still present within the KYCourts/CourtNet database and may still be utilized. Not every UOR code included in the query will have charges associated with it in each calendar year examined. Some cases may contain multiple charges; therefore, charge counts may exceed case counts. The number of cases cannot be inferred as the number of individuals as multiple cases may have the same defendant.
