

GENERAL ORDER 2021-1

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Fayette County Sheriff shall be given permission to offer a "Fine Payment Forgiveness Program" for any Defendant who has outstanding process from the Show Cause/Fine Payment Docket. During this time, any Defendant who has had a warrant issued for failure to appear for a fine payment, the Defendant may go directly to the Sheriff's Office where they will be escorted to the Clerk's Office to pay their fine without penalty. The "Fine Payment Forgiveness Program" shall take effect June 1, 2021 and go through August 31, 2021. In addition, a Sheriff's Fee of forty (\$40.00) dollars shall be added to each case.
