## NOTICE CONCERNING A VACANCY IN THE OFFICE OF DISTRICT JUDGE 47TH JUDICIAL DISTRICT DISTRICT COURT

The death of Kevin R. Mullins, District Judge, on September 19, 2024, created a vacancy in the office of **District Judge, 47th Judicial District**, consisting of Letcher County. To be eligible to serve as a District Judge you must:

- (a) be a citizen of the United States;
- (b) have been a resident of both the Commonwealth of Kentucky and of the district in which you seek appointment for two years next preceding taking office, and
- (c) be licensed to practice law in the courts of the Commonwealth as well as a licensed attorney for at least two years.

Any person meeting these qualifications and desiring consideration for nomination to the Governor, or any citizen desiring to recommend a person or persons with these qualifications, \*<u>shall notify the Judicial Nominating</u> <u>Commission by communicating the name(s) to the executive secretary on</u> <u>or before February 7, 2025</u>, (see SCR 6.030).
