The initial Judgment and Order of Involuntary Commitment of Respondent having been entered by this Court in the above-styled action on _____, 2____, and in accordance with KRS 202C.060 requiring this Court to conduct review hearings in the above-styled action for the purpose of determining whether Respondent should remain in a forensic psychiatric facility for continued care and treatment, and this Court being otherwise sufficiently advised, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. This review hearing is: (check either A. or B.)

A. a regularly scheduled **STANDARD** or **HEIGHTENED** hearing as indicated below, pursuant to the schedule set out in KRS 202C.060(2), to determine whether Respondent should remain in a forensic psychiatric facility for continued care and treatment: (check one)

(1) First **STANDARD** review hearing: First **STANDARD** review hearing is required **NO SOONER THAN 90 DAYS AND NO LATER THAN 120 DAYS FROM ENTRY** of this Court's initial Judgment and Order of Involuntary Commitment.

(2) After the first **STANDARD** review hearing and during the first two years after entry of this Court's initial Judgment and Order of Involuntary Commitment: **STANDARD** review hearing is required **NOT LESS THAN 180 DAYS AND NOT MORE THAN 210 DAYS FROM THE MOST RECENT REVIEW HEARING**. (3) Beginning two years after entry of this Court's initial Judgment and Order of Involuntary Commitment: **STANDARD** review hearing is required **NOT MORE THAN 365 DAYS FROM THE MOST RECENT REVIEW HEARING**. The most recent review hearing was held on _____, 2____.

(4) **NOT MORE THAN FIVE YEARS AFTER ENTRY** of this Court's initial Judgment and Order of Involuntary Commitment or, if applicable, **NOT MORE THAN FIVE YEARS AFTER THE MOST RECENT HEIGHTENED REVIEW HEARING, A HEIGHTENED** review hearing is required.

B. in response to a request by Respondent or Respondent's guardian ad litem for a review hearing, pursuant to KRS 202C.060(1)(b), on the basis that there has been a material change in circumstances or there is new evidence to present to the Court establishing that Respondent no longer meets the criteria for involuntary commitment.

Unless Respondent, through counsel, has waived Respondent's right to be present, Respondent shall be present in person or remotely, except that: in any **HEIGHTENED** review hearing, Respondent shall be physically present, and if Respondent is unable to attend for any reason, the review hearing shall be rescheduled to a time, place, and manner in which Respondent is able to attend.

3. This review hearing shall be heard by the undersigned Judge without a jury unless Respondent requests a jury. Respondent shall be entitled to a jury upon request only if Respondent has not had a review hearing with a jury during the preceding 12 months.

4. Respondent shall be examined without unnecessary delay by _____, a Kentucky Licensed Physician, and _____, a Qualified Mental Health Professional, who shall file a certification of their findings with this Court within seven (7) days prior to the review hearing scheduled herein, excluding weekends and holidays.

5. The review hearing indicated above in paragraph 1. shall be held on _____, 2____ at _____ a.m. p.m. at _____ to determine whether Respondent should remain in a forensic psychiatric facility for continued care and treatment.
