**INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING AFFIDAVIT TO CHALLENGE GARNISHMENT**

1. Fill out the Affidavit to Challenge Garnishment with the appropriate information. State why the money/property is exempt and the amount exempted.
2. Sign and swear to the form in front of a Notary Public or Circuit Court Clerk. The Notary or Clerk will complete **Box 1**.
3. Give the form to the Circuit Court Clerk. **DO NOT DETACH** any copies from the form. If you printed this from the Internet, you must submit the signed original and two (2) copies to the Clerk.
4. When the Clerk receives this Affidavit/Form, he/she will schedule a hearing, complete **Box 2**, and notify you of the hearing. He/She will also mail copies of the affidavit to the attorney for the Judgment Creditor.
