ORDER

The Petitioner, an adult adopted person, having filed a petition to inspect adoption records and the Cabinet for Health and Family Services having been ordered by the court to search for the biological parents, and the Cabinet having filed an affidavit with the court and the court being sufficiently advised, finds that the Cabinet for Health and Family Services:

- has notified the biological parents and they have consented by filing an affidavit with the court to authorize petitioner to inspect adoption records.
- has notified the biological parents and they have in writing refused to consent to an inspection of adoption records by the adult adopted person.
- has determined that the biological parents listed on the original birth certificate of the above-named adult adopted person are deceased.
- has been unable to locate the biological parents listed on the original birth certificate of the above-named adult adopted person.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- that the Circuit Court Clerk and/or the Cabinet for Health and Family Services will make available for inspection and/or provide a copy of adoption records of the above-named petitioner.
- that the biological parents are deceased or cannot be located; however, only information identifying the biological parents shall be shared with the adult adopted person.
- that the biological parents are deceased or cannot be located and your petition to inspect your adoption records is denied.
- that the biological parents have denied access to your adoption records; therefore, your petition to inspect your adoption records is denied.
