NOTICE CONCERNING A VACANCY IN THE OFFICE OF CIRCUIT FAMILY JUDGE 42ND JUDICIAL CIRCUIT, FAMILY DIVISION 2

The retirement of Rob Mattingly, effective November 3, 2019, created a vacancy in the office of Circuit Judge, 42nd Judicial Circuit, Family Division 2, consisting of Calloway and Marshall counties. To be eligible to serve as a Circuit Family Judge you must:

To be eligible to serve as a Circuit Family Judge you must:

- (a) be a citizen of the United States;
- (b) have been a resident of both the Commonwealth of Kentucky and of the circuit in which you seek appointment for two years next preceding taking office, and
- (c) be licensed to practice law in the courts of the Commonwealth as well as a licensed attorney for at least eight years.

Any person meeting these qualifications and desiring consideration for nomination to the Governor, or any citizen desiring to recommend a person or persons with these qualifications, *shall notify the Judicial Nominating Commission by communicating the name(s) to the executive secretary on or before **January 30, 2020**, (see SCR 6.030).
