

**June 1, 2020**

Pursuant to the Kentucky Supreme Court Order 2020 - 39, 40, 43, and 44, the Fayette Circuit Court hereby orders the following:

**CIVIL COURT**

- All Civil Trials are cancelled until August 1<sup>st</sup>, per KY Supreme Court Order 2020-40.
- All Civil Pre-trials shall proceed by telephone or by Zoom. Please contact each Division.
- All motions should be noticed for Motion Hours, then the Court will schedule most civil motions by Zoom at a separate time.

All individuals are advised to wear a mask and adhere to social distancing guidance provided inside the courthouse. In no event may attendance exceed 33% of the Courtroom's capacity pursuant to the Kentucky Supreme Court 's Orders 2020 – 39, 40, 43 and 44.
