### PRETRIAL INTERVIEWS BOOKED DURING FY 2021 & CHARGES DISPOSED DURING FY 2021 STATEWIDE

March 23, 2022

### **Statistics Request Overall Description**

On February 28, 2022, the Legislative Research Commission requested a report of persons arrested in Kentucky during Fiscal Year (FY) 2021, and of those, the number of charges disposed as well as the number of charges pending.

PRIM, the case management information system used by Pretrial Services, was queried for pretrial interviews statewide with a booking date between 7/1/2020 through 6/30/2021.

A second query was performed from CourtNet, which provides a summary of cases statewide, queried for charges having a disposition date between 7/1/2020 and 6/30/2021.

### Statistical Report (22\_PINS7001)

The report consists of a single page with two cross tables:

**Table 1:** Provides the Pretrial Interviews statewide with a booking date between 7/1/2020 through 6/30/2021. This table is grouped by Jurisdiction and the "Has Pending Charge category", with counts provided for charges, cases, interviews, and defendants.

**Table 2:** Provides a cross table of charges disposed during the requested timeframe. This table is grouped by Jurisdiction and by charge disposition category, with counts provided for charges, cases, interviews, and defendants.

### **Statistical Analysis Considerations:**

- > The statistics presented in the tables are a snapshot in time as of the March 23, 2022.
- > Each interview may involve one or more cases.
- > Interviews involving a circuit criminal case with a summons and no arrest were excluded.
- > Counts of interviews count each interview only once. A single interview may have separate Release Decisions and Outcomes in Circuit and District Court. The same interview may appear in more than one subtotal within a table but will never be counted more than once in any cell, subtotal, or grand total.
- > A case may consist of one or multiple charges. The report's count of cases represents a distinct count of case numbers, regardless of the number of charges associated with the case.

### Statistical Report (22\_PINS7001)

- > Counts of cases do not necessarily represent counts of unique individuals.
- > "DCTG Drug Court Transfer Guilty" is excluded from table 2, as the charges will be in the originating county and not entered within the case of the county it was transferred to.
- > Charges consist of all original, amended and added charges within a case.
- > Charges include ASCF Codes: 1- Attempt, 2- Solicitation, 3- Conspiracy, 4- Facilitation, 5- Complicity, 6- Enhancement.

PRIM (Table 1)	Jurisdiction	Indicates Circuit or District primarily so as to differentiate Circuit and District criminal cases within interviews and their distinct processes.
	Booking Date	The date a defendant was booked into jail for a specified case. The information is provided by the detention center and can be obtained from booking documents or electronically. In some contexts, this date is labelled "Arrest Date" in PRIM, and it is considered synonymous with arrest date for reporting and analytical purposes.
	Has Pending Charge	Since there are currently 71 unique disposition codes coming from CourtNet, similar dispositions are grouped together for reporting purposes, and the simpler "Disposition" label is applied to this field. It is created from a hidden "Charge Disposition Group" field then interpreted through an additional calculation to separate NULL dispositions from CourtNet (pending charges) from those where NULL is caused by the lack of a CourtNet match.  The aggregations are calculated as follows:  Charges Pending: The number of charges per record without a disposition date and with a CourtNet match.  Charges Disposed: The number of charges per record with a disposition date and a CourtNet match.  Convictions: The number of charges with at least one disposition grouped as Conviction in the Disposition field.  Indictments: The number of charges disposed as INDICTMENT BY GRAND JURY / INFORMATION.  Charges Missing: The number of charges per record without a CourtNet match.

		The total number of charges per record is the sum of Charges Pending, Charges Disposed, and Charges Missing. Convictions are a subset of Charges Disposed.		
	Charges	The count of charges filed within each case within an Interview.		
	Cases	The total number of distinct cases, counting distinct cases independent from the possibility that the same case may appear in multiple interviews over time.		
	Interviews	The number of distinct pretrial interviews. The pretrial interview is the central data unit used in PRIM, capturing any data related to a discrete period of pretrial custody for a single defendant, which may apply to one or more cases. A single defendant may have multiple pretrial interviews during any given period of time.		
	Defendants	A count of distinct defendants. Instances in which the same defendant is involved in more than one pretrial interview are identified when a Pretrial Officer connects the identification of the defendant in a pretrial interview to the identification entered for previous interview involving the same defendant.		
	CourtNet Match	Binary indication of whether the county and case number as entered in PRIM could be matched to case entry in CourtNet.  The total number of cases per Interview & Jurisdiction without such a match is indicated by the Cases Missing measure.		
CourtNet (Table 2)	Charge Disposition Date	The date in which each charge was disposed. Different charges within the same case may have separate disposition dates.

The Kentucky State Police (KSP) assigns the Kentucky Uniform Crime Reporting Codes (UOR Codes) to criminal offenses in the Commonwealth of Kentucky. The KSP official list of UOR Codes by KRS number and descriptor can be obtained at the KSP's website at www.kentuckystatepolice.org.

The AOC assigns and maintains codes that are used within the Court of Justice Case Management System for statistical and reporting purposes. These codes are used to identify local and city ordinances, as well as codes for general administrative purposes. The AOC official list of UOR Codes with KRS number and descriptor can be obtained at the Court of Justice Website at courts.ky.gov/aoc/statisticalreports. The AOC UOR Code Listing is for informational purposes only and the information is subject to change, reprogramming, modifications of format, and availability at the direction of the Administrative Office of the Courts (AOC).

A query for data based on specified charges will include each UOR code specified and possible supplemental codes. Supplemental codes (or "ASCF" codes) to any UOR code include: 1) attempt, 2) solicitation, 3) conspiracy, 4) facilitation, 5) complicity, and 6) enhancement. In total, UOR codes contain seven digits. The first six digits are specific to that charge. The seventh digit indicates if there is a supplemental code. A "0" as the seventh digit means that is the primary UOR code and it does not have a supplemental code. If there are supplemental codes, the "0" will change to a 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, or 6 (the numbering corresponds to the list above). An enhancement does not exist on all UOR codes. When a supplemental code does not appear within a dataset, charge(s) did not occur during this period. The presence of "\*obs" within the description of a UOR code indicates an obsolete UOR code. However, the code is still present within the KYCourts/CourtNet database and may still be utilized. Not every UOR code included in the query will have charges associated with it in each calendar year examined. Some cases may contain multiple charges; therefore, charge counts may exceed case counts. The number of cases cannot be inferred as the number of individuals as multiple cases may have the same defendant.
