Signage Notice for March 13, 2020

Justices, Judges, Circuit Court Clerks & AOC Executive Officers and Managers:

Please post attached sign at all public entrances to your court facility Signs to be posted March 16-April 10

In today's <u>Supreme Court order</u> restricting court operations, section 15 requires court facilities to post signs at public entrances to prevent high-risk individuals from entering. To save time, the 8.5x11 sign is attached so that you can print it on-site and post it right away. We will email updated signs when there are changes to the countries listed in subsection a.

Here is the language from that section of the order:

- 15. Signage shall be posted at all public entry points advising individuals not to enter the building if they have:
 - a) In the previous 14 days, visited China, Iran, South Korea, any European countries, or any other high-risk countries identified by the CDC;
 - b) Resided with or been in close contact with someone who has been in any of those countries within the previous 14 days;
 - c) Traveled domestically within the United States where COVID-19 has sustained widespread community transmission;
 - d) Been asked to self-quarantine by any doctor, hospital, or health agency;
 - e) Been diagnosed with or have had contact with anyone who has been diagnosed with COVID-19; or
 - f) A fever, cough or shortness of breath.
