Signage Notice for April 10, 2020

Justices, Judges, Circuit Court Clerks & AOC Executive Officers and Managers:

2 public entrance signs now available in 12 languages Signs restricting access to court facilities to be posted through May 1, 2020

In the amended Supreme Court [order](#) issued April 1, section 16 requires court facilities to post signs at public entrances to prevent high-risk individuals from entering. In addition, a second sign reflects the suspension of in-person services through May 1. These more stringent social-distancing measures were taken in anticipation of a surge in COVID-19 cases.

Since issuing these two signs in English on April 1, the AOC Department of Language Access has translated them into 11 of the languages most frequently encountered in courthouses and judicial centers statewide. We appreciate Language Access for making this important information available in several languages.

Signs should be posted at entrances to reflect the languages most commonly encountered in that facility. The signs are 8.5x11 and can be printed in your office by clicking on the language below:
