Justices, Judges, Circuit Court Clerks, AOC Executive Officers & Managers and Court Administrators:

Updated Facilities Closed sign announces in-person services suspended until May 31

Sign available in 12 languages for use at court facilities

The Supreme Court of Kentucky recently issued an amended [order](#) extending the suspension of in-person services through May 31. The sign to inform the public that a facility is closed has been updated to reflect this date. The Facilities Closed sign is available in 12 languages and is to be posted through May 31, 2020.

Thank you to the AOC Department of Language Access for translating this sign into the languages most frequently encountered in judicial centers and courthouses statewide. The sign should be posted at entrances in the languages most commonly encountered in that facility. The signs are 8.5x11 and can be printed in your office by clicking on the language below:
